

**Husky Energy - Expression of Interest (EOI) / Prequalification
Accommodation Management Services – Reference 8.24.1.229**

Husky Energy (Husky), operator of the White Rose project, is seeking Expressions of Interest (EOI's) and Prequalification responses from interested companies for the provision of **Accommodation Management Services** for the SeaRose Floating Production, Storage and Offloading (FPSO) vessel.

General Requirements

Interested companies must be qualified to conduct the work as outlined in the Scope of Work below and are asked to demonstrate their capabilities and experience via a formal response to the Prequalification Questionnaire. The Prequalification Questionnaire is based on Husky Operational Integrity Management System (HOIMS) and contains detailed questions regarding your company's technical, HSE-Q and commercial capabilities.

Scope of Work

The Scope of Work includes the provision of personnel and resources to carry out and manage catering and accommodation support services to the SeaRose FPSO. Specific requirements include, but are not limited to:

- Provision of personnel in conjunction with respective Husky guidelines
- Ordering, preparing and serving sufficient quantity and variety of food and drink for all SeaRose residents and visitors
- Provision and replenishment of bed linens, pillows, blankets/duvets, bath towels, face towels
- Operation of waste compactor, washing devices, refrigeration storage and ovens. Maintenance of equipment to be co-coordinated through Company Representative
- Provision of janitorial services including laundry and dry cleaning services
- Organization and co-ordination of accommodations services and personnel on board administration duties as required
- Provision of recreation and entertainment services, including the provision of videos, books and recreational games
- Operation of a kiosk shop on the SeaRose FPSO
- Participation in emergency services teams as required
- Provision and management of food shipment containers

As a minimum standard, respondents are expected to provide and maintain the following:

- Top quality, well prepared and nutritious meals from a varied menu
- Highest possible standard of cleanliness and hygiene
- Properly qualified, field experienced trained and demonstrably competent catering personnel and provision of ad hoc contract staff as required
- Supplementary services to day visitors
- A full time local Manager based in St. John's, NL with office facilities to act as Contractor's representative.

Husky strongly supports providing opportunities to Canadian and, in particular, Newfoundland and Labrador companies and individuals, on a commercially competitive basis. Pre-qualified companies will be required to complete a Canada/Newfoundland and Labrador Benefits Questionnaire should your company be requested to submit a bid. Husky also encourages the participation of members of designated groups (women; Aboriginal peoples; persons with disabilities; and members of visible minorities) and corporations or cooperatives owned by them, in the supply of goods and services.
