

**West White Rose Project
Request for Information (RFI)
Tubular Management Services - Reference No. 8.41.1.006**

Husky Energy Inc. (Husky), operator of the White Rose field and satellite extensions, is seeking supplier information relating to Tubular Management Services for the West White Rose Platform (WWRP). At a high level, Husky is interested in the following:

- 1. Procurement Services**
- 2. Inventory Management**
- 3. Technical Services**
- 4. Third Party Coordination**

Specific points of interest include but are not limited to:

- Facilities and infrastructure
- End-to-end procurement services for Oil Country Tubular Goods (OCTG) including ancillary equipment.
- Technical subject matter expert support
- In-mill production monitoring services
- Expediting
- OCTG market intelligence
- Direct coordination and contracting of any required third-party services such as:
 - Bucking
 - OCTG Inspection Services
 - Field Thread Representatives (FTR)
 - Licensed Thread Representatives (LTR)
 - Repairs
 - Third party quality oversight
 - Threading
 - Purchasing of consumables such as slings, chocks etc.
- Coordination of trucking services for out of province moves
- Inventory database (incl. maintenance, reporting and access management)
- Inventory counts
- Inventory storage and preservation
- Coordination and documentation of all tubular movements.
- Maintain records of all receipts, shipments load outs and returns from offshore.
- Delivery schedule management
- Backload management
- Reporting of material movements
- Process and documentation for yard activities
- Security
- Export documentation
- Proposed alternatives to keep a low-cost structure based on number of wells, tonnage, etc.
- Proposed delivery timelines and scheduling models given different supply scenarios (i.e. 5 wells, 10 wells, etc.).
- Details around how different supply scenarios affect mill bookings, suggested optimized mill schedule.

Background Information

- Anticipated timeline for start-up on the West White Rose Platform is early 2022.
- Platform can accommodate up to 40 wells. Estimated well consumption is 640 metric tons per well.
- Consideration will be given to combined services as well as standalone options.
